



SECOND GRADE CURRICULUM

IN SECOND GRADE MATH the students will:

- build fluency with addition and subtraction
- determine the value of money
- model fractions
- understand geometric shapes and measure length, area, capacity, and weight
- solve three-digit addition and subtraction problems
- begin multiplication

IN SECOND GRADE READING/LANGUAGE ARTS the students will:

- identify the parts of a sentence
- identify and correctly use the parts of speech
- read and comprehend a variety of genres
- produce and write in complete sentences
- construct paragraphs with topic sentences and supporting details
- be able to summarize a text
- participate in book reports to demonstrate understanding of a book

IN SECOND GRADE SCIENCE & HEALTH the students will:

- plan and conduct simple experiments
- identify how ecosystems work
- observe and measure matter
- observe the relationship between forces and motion
- gain a basic understanding of how sounds are produced
- learn about personal health and safety

IN SECOND GRADE SOCIAL STUDIES the students will:

- learn about and compare communities including their own
- discover how things change over time
- understand cultural connections
- learn more about our government—specifically voting, rights, and taxes
- gain a deeper understanding of geography using maps

IN SECOND GRADE RELIGION , the students will:

- understand the Trinity
- understand the dignity of the human person
- be exposed to various Old Testament stories
- learn to pray the rosary
- recognize the importance of participating in the sacrament of Penance
- define the Eucharist as Jesus's Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity
