IN FIFTH GRADE MATH the students will:

- understand place value from thousandths to millions
- organize, display, and interpret data
- understand how to calculate with decimals and fractions
- classify geometric figures and develop spatial reasoning
- measure volume in prisms
- compare fractions and convert to decimals
- understand mathematical expressions
- measuring data with graphing
- master long division
